So much so that the objects around us pre-chew reality to make it more digestible. Serendipity is abandoned in favor of well-marked, comfortable but well-trodden paths. Stereotypes wander clumsily, and lacking the narrative to articulate them better, they fail to represent. As a result, the future struggles to materialize, and we find meaning in chance. Olivier Bémer is a graduate of ECAL, Beaux-Arts de Paris and Le Fresnoy Studio National. His work has been shown at the Pernod-Ricard foundation, at the Emerige foundation prize, and at the Fiminco foundation.




